There is a focus on returning to school, further training and pathways to meaningful employment. Over the past twenty years nearly 3000 young Australians are Operation Newstart graduates.

BENEFITS

- 85% of participants remain in school for a further two years after completion
- Evidence of reduction in offending
- Improvements in emotional well-being
- Acquisition of life skills that foster individual achievement
- Enhanced confidence and self esteem
- Improved social skills
- New friendships



Participants spend a whole school term with the Operation Newstart team, three days on program and two days in their school settings. Small group work and unique learning experiences encourage them to make better choices around their physical and mental wellbeing. Many activities have a challenging outdoors/adventure focus in natural settings. Exploring vocational pathways, community service and re-engagement with school and family are key elements.

Five programs statewide are facilitated by qualified outdoor education teachers, youth workers, social workers and partner organisations including local police, schools, local government, human services and health professionals. More than 60 secondary schools referred 164 students into our programs in 2018. There is no cost to students or their families.
